#### CRITICAL THINGS TO KNOW

STAGE DELIVERY - We'll need a confident driver to help us get the stage into this proposed location.

PORTION OF ADJACENT PARKING LOT IS NOT FOR OUR USE - All teammates, please note that there is a section of the Moncrief Cancer Institute parking lot that is directly adjacent to the stage and looks incredibly convenient to use for band arrivals, box truck staging, etc. UNFORTUNATELY WE CANNOT USE THIS AREA as MCI has two large tour-bus sized mobile cancer screening units that require this area for their storage. These units are being displaced from their traditional parking lot due to the festival and they must have exclusive use of this parking lot on the western side of MCI (see map, note area that is blocked). MCI will be coning off this area on Friday morning. We cannot use this area at any time during ArtsGoggle. The mobile units will come and go throughout the day on both Friday and Saturday and even when they are not in the parking lot we have been told we cannot use the parking lot. This is a non-negotiable, unfortunately.

GREEN ROOM ON SATURDAY DURING ARTSGOGGLE, there will be an indoor ArtsGoggle artists and partners lounge located inside Moncrief Cancer Institute. This can serve as indoor restrooms for stage crew and bands, indoor break area, and indoor green room as needed. All partners who enter must have an official ArtsGoggle badge. Tony Diaz will be responsible for distributing and collecting stage badges as needed. Becky Bethel is the Near Southside teammate responsible for managing green room and can be contacted inside of MCI if there is a problem needing her attention.

# IF YOU DIDN'T GET YOUR PREFERRED BLOCK

please allow me to explain why. Artists are placed west to east (block 1 to block 21). The western blocks are where the festival historically started and over the years we have expanded to the east. Artists who have participated for many years are most familiar with the western blocks and often request those due to their familiarity. Those blocks (blocks 2-14) always receive more request than we can realistically hold so as each block is filled, requests are rolled forward...like squeezing the toothpaste forward in the tube. This year we are TOTALLY FULL with every single block filled without any wiggle space. We placed artist giving priority to artist placement based on block requested, the date that your application was submitted, any specific reason why this location is important (partnering with an indoor venue on this block or living within walking distance for restroom use). We also worked hard to group all artists together. If you did not receive your preference, it wasn't that we didn't care or didn't try. We ask for your understanding.
